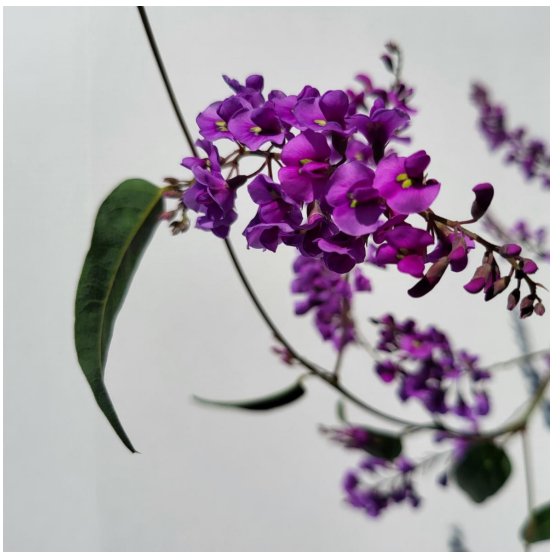

Featured Plants



Spring is in the air, but nights are still cold. Some flowers are blooming, while others remain dormant or in early stages of growth. If you want a vivid pop of color in your late winter/early spring San Jose garden, consider some of the beautiful varieties below:



Hardenbergia violacea
'Happy Wanderer'

- Evergreen vine
- Prefers sun / light shade
- Cascading, delicate purple flowers winter to spring
- Drought resistant
- Prune after flowering
- Largely pest and disease free

Gazania rigens



'Giant Deep Orange'

- Aka: African Daisy
- Low maintenance
- Attracts bees & butterflies
- Giant, long-blooming flowers
- Full sun, minimal water
- Tender perennial zones 8-11
- Deadhead for frequent blooming



Camellia sasanqua 'Shishi Gashira'

- Hot pink semi double blooms
- Glossy, dark green foliage
- Fall and winter blooming
- Prefers filtered sun
- More compact; 3' to 4'
- Moist, draining acidic soil
- Cut flowers, borders, containers, flower garden



Iberis sempervirens 'Snowflake Candytuft'

- Delicate white flowers
- 10" tall; 3' to 4' spread
- Profuse flowering in spring
- Charming filler for edges, crevices, or as groundcover
- Attracts butterflies
- Tolerant of urban pollution
- Full sun/partial shade

Abutilon 'Thompsonii' Variegated Flowering Maple

- Showy, bell-shaped flowers
- Fuzzy, soft dark green foliage speckled with yellow
- Evergreen shrub, small tree



- Blooms year round frost-free
- Gardens, borders, containers
- Grows 6' to 10' ft tall
- Full sun to part shade
