New Products



Philotheca myoporoides 'Profusion'

This hardy, compact shrub grows to 4-5 ft. tall and wide. In late winter and early spring, pink buds open to a profusion of white flowers. It has aromatic leaves that are somewhat reminiscent of the apple fragrance



Protea 'Pink Ice'

A stunning and tough dense evergreen shrub that grows to 8 feet tall by nearly as wide with attractive leathering long narrow leaves and silvery-pink flowers from fall into winter. One of the first of the protea to bloom; often will have flowers for a when the plant is brushed against or if the leaves are crushed. Does best in dappled shade; tolerates full sun.



Agapanthus praecox 'Silver Streak'

Hardy evergreen perennial. Grows to about 2 ft tall & clumps to about 3 ft wide with undulating variegated leaves that are over 1 inch wide and 24 to 30 inch long with strong cream colored margins and finer cream striations on the green center of the leaf. In early to mid-summer appear the medium-sized blue flowers on 3-4 foot tall stalks. Hardy to 20-25 F. solid 9 months or more. Good frost tolerance, down to low 20's F; ability to tolerate a wide range of soil types.



Mangave 'Lavender Lady'

Mangave is a relatively new phenomenon, an intergeneric cross of Manfreda x Agave. These rare hybrids combine the best of both worlds: the better growth rate & the interesting patterns of Manfreda, and the habit & refinement of Agave. 'Lavender Lady' is a unique, feminine beauty whose solitary rosette habit & smoky purple coloration make it look very similar to an Echeveria.

California Monarch Butterflies: How Can We Help?


San Diego Zoo Global sounded the alarm Monday after a count in November showed the population of monarch butterflies falling to an all-time low in California. Monarch populations in California are threatened by a number of factors but conservationists want people to know that there are steps the community can take to save the butterflies:



- **Plant native:** Native plants, and in particular native milkweed, give monarchs their best chance for success.
- Choose nectar-rich plants: Migrating adult monarchs must have access to nectar in the early spring, and they will navigate through urban gardens to get it.
- **Plant now:** Get native plants and seeds into the ground ahead of the winter rains.
- **Record observations:** Biologists still lack key information about the movement of western monarchs. Add your observations to the Western Monarch Milkweed Mapper or the Monarch Larva Monitoring Project.


