JANUARY FEATURED PLANTS

Your January garden doesn't need to be drab and lifeless there are so many options to keep your plantings looking fresh, vibrant, and full of color and texture through the Winter months. Many succulents are turning vivid shades of red and orange, some perennials are flowering, and we are getting in new shipments of native plants every month. Not sure where to start? Check out some of our favorite winter plant varieties below:

Euphorbia martini 'Tiny Tim'

- Striking foliage
- Dwarf evergreen subshrub
- Grows up to 12" tall and wide
- Prefers part shade to full sun
- Very long flowering season



- Burgundy, purple, dark green
- Hardy to 0 degrees



Kalanchoe orgyalis 'Copper Spoons'

- Unique, fuzzy texture
- Interesting copper and silver coloration
- Year-round interest
- Evergreen succulent
- Prefers full sun
- Hardy to 20 degrees



Opuntia violacea 'Santa-Rita Tubac Prickly Pear'

- Dramatic foliage colors
- Year-round interest
- Edible pads and fruits
- Red-yellow flowers in spring
- Tolerant of poor soils
- Prefers full sun
- Hardy to 10 degrees


Euphorbia 'Sticks on Fire'

- Evergreen succulent
- Fantastic green-red foliage
- Resembles sea coral with pencil thin branches



- Salt tolerant
- Deer and rabbit resistant
- Grows 4-8 ft tall and wide
- Hardy to 30 degrees


