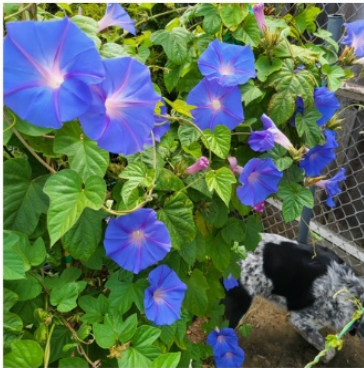

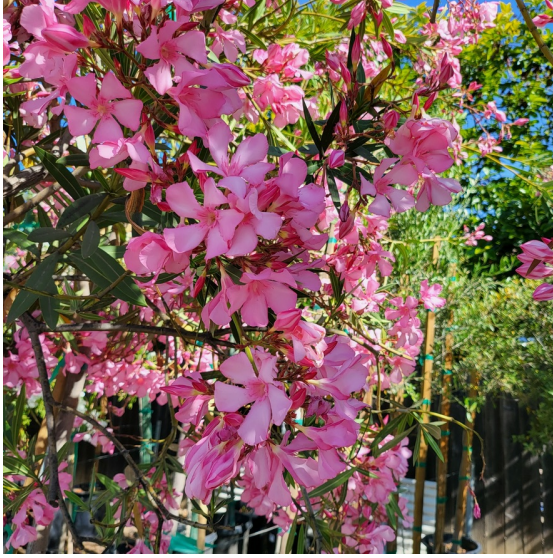
Featured Plants



June is one of the most exciting months in the nursery, as late spring bursts forth in a riot of color and foliage. While the extreme heat and drought threatens many gardens, if you choose your plants carefully you can have a colorful, vivid yard and garden full of hummingbirds and beneficial pollinators even in the midst of drought. Read about some of our favorites below and find more drought and heat tolerant plants at the nursery.

Nerium 'Pink' **Pink Oleander**

- Shrub or small tree
- Large, pink 5 petaled flowers bloom throughout the year
- Also available in white, red, light pink
- Ideal for gardens, coastal landscapes, containers

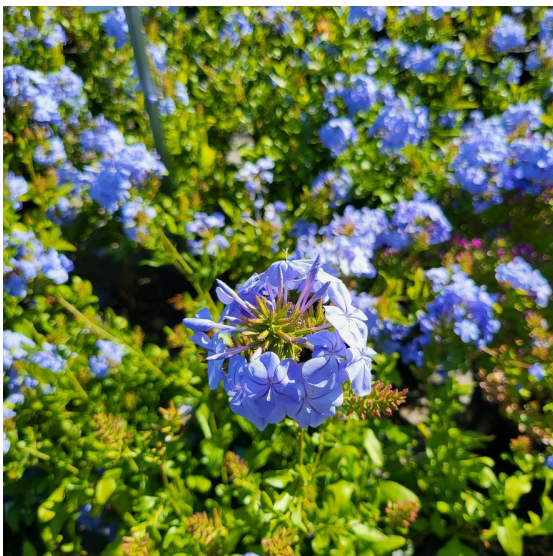


- Heat & drought tolerant
- Full sun



Penstemon heterophyllus 'Catherine De La Mare'

- California native
- Eye-catching, lilac blue-purple flowers bloom periodically spring to fall
- Long, graceful stems, grows up to 18"
- Heat & drought tolerant
- Attracts bees, hummingbirds
- Full sun to light shade



Plumbago auriculata 'Royal Cape'

- Large, vibrant blue flower clusters bloom spring-fall
- Graceful, rambling shrub reaches 5 ft tall x 6 ft wide
- Heat and drought tolerant once established
- Great for containers, gardens, accent, screens
- Prefers full sun to part shade

Erigeron glaucus 'Cape Sebastian'

- Bay area native
- Low growing with copious violet colored daisies



- Blooms spring to autumn
- Ideal for coastal gardens, borders, meadows
- Attracts bees, butterflies
- Heat & drought tolerant
- Full sun to light shade



Achillea millefolium
'Sunny Seduction'

- Bright, soft yellow flowers
- Mass planting, cut flowers
- Ideal for seaside & rock gardens, naturalized areas, ground cover
- Blooms June to September
- Attracts butterflies
- Heat & drought tolerant
- Full sun
