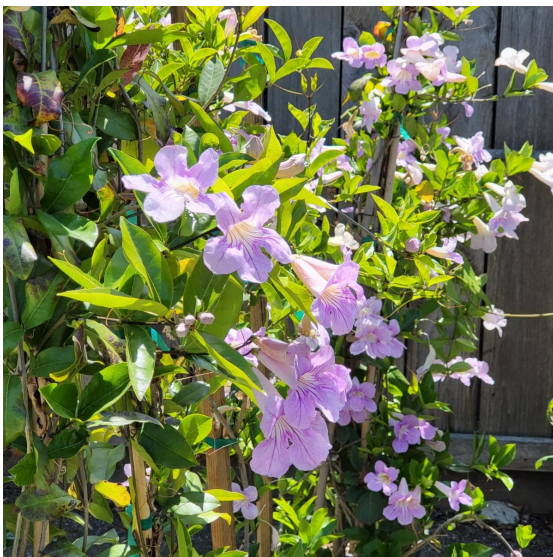


## Featured Plants

These are just a few of the many vines flowering right now in the nursery. Check out some of our favorites below, and stop by the nursery for more flowering vines and hundreds of other gorgeous flowering plants to add color and life to your landscapes.



***Clytostoma callistegioides***  
**Violet Trumpet Vine**

- Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies
- Light purple, trumpet shaped flowers
- Great for large scale & privacy plantings
- Blooms Spring through Summer
- Prefers sun to part shade

***Pandorea jasminoides***



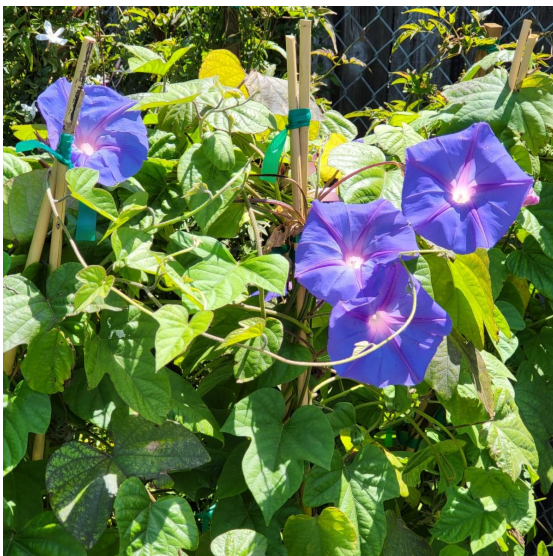
### 'Rosea' Pink Bower Vine

- Light pink, funnel shaped flowers with dark pink throat
- Can grow 20-30 ft
- Trellis, arbor, fence, wall cover
- Long-blooming, red trumpet-shaped flowers
- Full sun or part shade
- Jasmine scent



### Mandevilla hybrida 'Bella Grande Pink'

- Vibrant pink trumpet shaped flowers
- Drought and heat tolerant
- Blooms Summer to Autumn
- Glossy oval leaves
- Great for containers or landscape
- Prefers full sun



### Ipomoea acuminata Morning Glory / Blue Dawn Vine

- Eye-catching, bright blue flowers open in morning and close at night
- Great for fences, latticework, large-scale, privacy
- Fast growing, long blooming
- Full sun or part shade

### Wisteria macrostachya 'Blue Moon'

- Foot-long clusters of scented lavender flowers
- Hardest variety of Wisteria
- Ideal for arbors, fences,



- trellises, patios
- Can bloom 3 times a season
- Attracts hummingbirds
- Full sun

Our pricing system is based on pot size. As a wholesale nursery carrying acres of plants of varying sizes from many different vendors, it could be challenging for customers to figure out what size plant they had picked out without searching for a staff member to provide the information.

Introducing our new pot size display, a solution developed by our staff who recognized the need for an easy, self service visual reference. This new display, modeled here by employees Chayse and Neo, provides an easy way for anyone to figure out the difference between a #03, #05 or #10 pot. You can find it in the nursery to the right of our front office, behind the 4" plant displays.

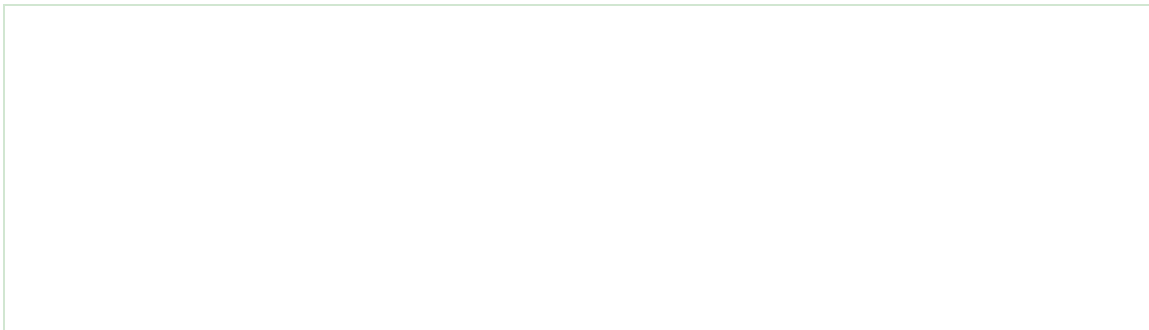
