Lantana "Spreading Sunset"

Keep Summer alive with Lantana



"Spreading Sunset," whose multicolored florets recall a sunset over the California oceans. Blooming in yellow to red shades nearly year-round, this is a great choice for borders, groundcover, or erosion control, adding a pop of color to landscape gardens in zones 9-11.



Gartenmeister Fuschia

Looking to attract bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds to your year-round garden? Try Gartenmeister Fuschia, an everblooming shrub in zones 9-11 with bundles of hanging lantern-shaped orange to red flowers. Requiring full to partial shade, this is a great choice for porches, patios, poolside or as a container plant.



Salvia 'Ember's Wish' (Sage)

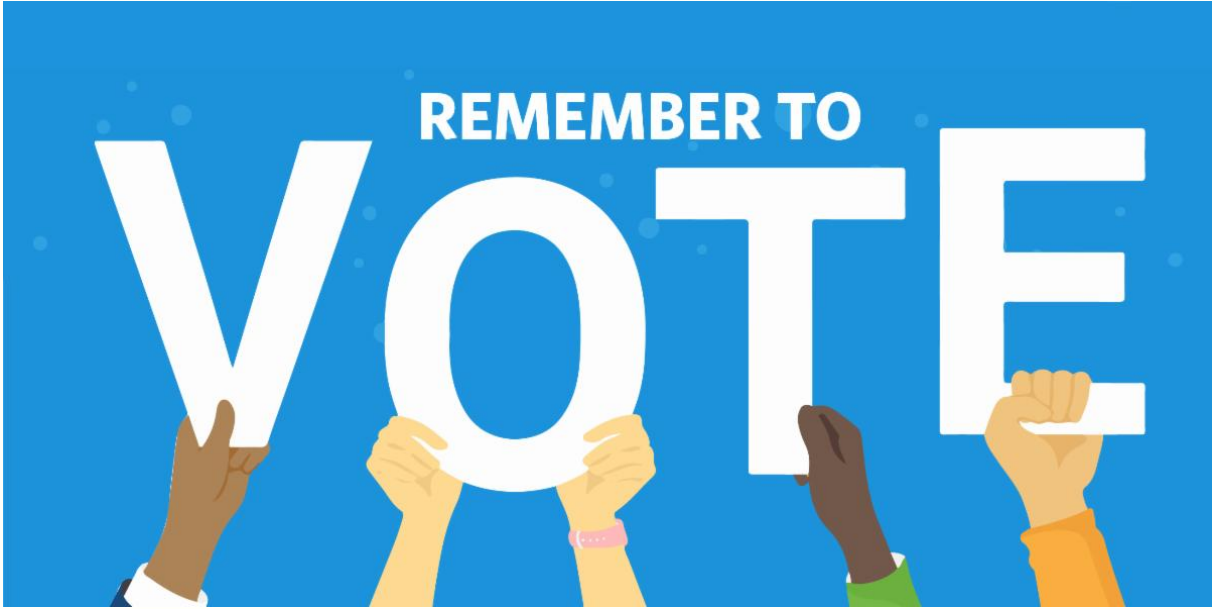
Salvia 'Ember's Wish' (Sage) is another long-bloomer for the Fall season. Fast-growing, deer resistant, and drought tolerant, this sun-loving favorite of hummingbirds is a great alternative to fuschia for sunnier spots and as a bonus, requires little to no deadheading or pruning. Excellent border, garden, or container choice.

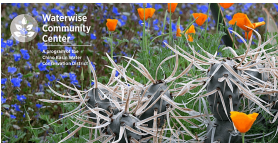
