Featured Plants



Salvias/sages are wonderful choices for the California garden landscape. Most are low-water, drought-tolerant, longblooming, and reach their peak in autumn, when other flowering plants are starting to drop their summer petals. Plus they're mostly easy care, stress free, and reward even the laziest maintenance with a profusion of flowers. Others are beautifully scented and attract hummingbirds, bees, birds and butterflies with their colorful blooms. We've chosen to feature some flowering varieties below, but there are also many other options in the nursery - from the lanky purple majesty, to the native compact white medicinal sage, and more - please visit us to see all that we have available!

> Salvia x Jamensis 'Sierra San Antonio' Jame Sage

One of our favorite salvias! - Pastel peach/pale yellow







flowers

- Grows to 18"+
- Loves full sun
- Low maintenance
- Low water needs
- Attracts bees, butterflies, birds

- Blooms repeatedly spring through fall

Salvia microphylla 'Hot Lips'

An eye-catching garden standout.

- Bicolor red/white flowers
- Blooms continuously all summer
- through first winter frost
- Drought and heat tolerant
- Grows quickly to 3' x 3'
- Aromatic small green leaves

- Attracts beneficial insects, hummingbirds, butterflies

Salvia gregii 'Fire Dancer'

A gregii; but with larger blooms!


- Bright, pink-orange flowers
- Grows 24-30"
- Larger, vivid flowers
- Blooms spring through winter
- Attracts hummingbirds
- Full sun to part shade
- Small, fragrant leaves
- Drought tolerant / low water

Salvia gregii 'Furman's Red' Red Autumn Sage

An easy, richly hued gregii.

- Magenta red flowers
- Grows to 24-36"





- Long blooming, easy-care
- Drought tolerant



Salvia buchananii 'Fashion Orange'

Vibrant and showily colorful.

- Vivid orange flower spikes on long stems
- Grows to 20-24"
- Showy and colorful
- Part shade or full sun
- Low water needs
- Blooms repeatedly spring through fall




