Featured Plants



Dianella revoluta 'Clarity Blue' - Blue Flax Lily:

This tough new hybrid gets strong upright Phormium-like growth from one parent and deep blue color from the other. Plays well with succulents, and makes a great container plant. (Desription from the Sunset Collection)



Leucospermum 'Tango' - Tango Pincushion: A

dense attractive upright shrub that grows to 6 to 8 feet tall by 4 to 6 feet wide with narrow long green leaves and brilliant bright orange flowers in late spring and early summer. The flowers are long stems and composed of orange stamens and red perianth ribbons. Plant out in the open in full sun in a well-drained soil and irrigate occasionally to infrequently. (Desription from San Marcos Growers)



Ribes sanguineum 'King Edward VII' - King Edward VII Flowering Currant: Pendulous clusters of vivid, crimson flowers make this the most richly colored variety. Blue black berries are a favorite of birds. A more compact grower than most, excellent as a hedge or in a mixed shrub border in native landscaping in cooler climates. Northwestern U.S. native selection. Deciduous. (Description from Monrovia)

More excellent choices now in the nursery:

Agapanthus africanus 'Ponto's Queen of the Nile' - Variegated Queen Ann Agapanthus: Introduced by Ponto Nursery this attractive evergreen perennial has variegated green & yellow foliage. Deer, gopher & fire tolerant. Good near pools, borders, pots & as a cut flower. Attracts butterflies. Blooms lavender blue spring-summer. Drought tolerant when established.

Acanthus mollis 'Oak Leaf' - Grecian Pattern Plant: Eye-catching structural element for partially shaded borders or background plantings. Grow for the large, lustrous, oak leaf-shaped foliage alone or enjoy the tall spires of lilac-tinged white flowers. Very tolerant of dry shade conditions when established. (Description from Monrovia)

Agonis flexuosa 'After Dark' - After Dark Peppermint Willow: An excellent small tree for use in containers, informal hedges, or as a landscape accent,. The striking semi-sweeping habit with dark burgundy foliage is adorned by white, burgundy-centered flowers in spring and summer. Tolerates windy and seaside conditions, and some drought in coastal regions when established. (Description from Monrovia)
