**Citrus Quarantine**

Last October the Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) was found in San Jose. Quarantine areas and treatment protocols were established by the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to prevent the spread of the insect and the associated disease Huanglongbing (HLB).

Until treatment and eradication of the pest has been completed (most likely several years) movement of citrus in and out of the quarantine area is greatly restricted. This means that we will not be shipping to sites outside the quarantine area. However treated plants may be picked-up at the nursery and there is no restriction as yet to where they are taken. The restricted area continues to widen with every new finding and an interactive map of affected areas can be found at:
