E.B. Stone Big Harvest Garden Soil Bale is an ideal soil conditioner. Great for planting and mulching.

Contains: aged redwood, aged fir bark, compost, dehydrated chicken manure, earthworm castings, bat guano, kelp meal and alfalfa meal.

Dianella tasmanica 'Silver Streak'- *Silver Streak*

Flax Lily: Handsome, strap-like, green and white-striped leaves that will brighten up garden beds and borders. The neat, clumping habit is ideal for massing as a groundcover. Delicate sprays of pale blue-violet flowers appear above the foliage in mid-spring; bright blue berries follow in summer. (Desription from Monrovia)



Agave shawii x attenuata 'Blue Flame' - Blue

Flame Agave: A beautiful clumping, hybrid agave. Rosettes of glaucous blue foliage resemble a blue gas flame, with gracefully incurved leaf tips. The edges of the fleshy

leaves often appear to glow when back-lit by late afternoon sunlight. This handsome, tough and drought tolerant plant lends a Mediterranean feel to sunny, dry gardens and is well-suited to containers. (Desription from Monrovia)



Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle' - Annabelle Hydrangea: Stunning pure white flowers, much larger than others of the species - up to 12 inches across! Blooms appear in late spring to summer, often continuing into fall. Strong, straight stems hold the huge flower heads up well, despite heavy rain. This full, lush shrub needs plenty of room to show off its spectacular beauty. (Description from Monrovia)

More excellent choices now in the nursery:

Agapanthus africanus 'Ponto's Queen of the Nile' - Variegated Agapanthus: Introduced by Ponto Nursery this attractive evergreen perennial has variegated green & yellow foliage. Deer, gopher & fire tolerant. Good near pools, borders, pots & as a cut flower. Attracts butterflies. Blooms lavender blue springsummer. Drought tolerant when established.

Acanthus mollis 'Oak Leaf' - Grecian Pattern Plant: Eye-catching structural element for partially shaded borders or background plantings. Grow for the large, lustrous, oak leaf-shaped foliage alone or enjoy the tall spires of lilac-tinged white flowers. Very tolerant of dry shade conditions when established. (Description from Monrovia)

Agonis flexuosa 'After Dark' - After Dark Peppermint Willow: An excellent small tree for use in containers, informal hedges, or as a landscape accent,. The striking semi-sweeping habit with dark burgundy foliage is adorned by white, burgundy-centered flowers in spring and summer. Tolerates windy and seaside conditions, and some drought in coastal regions when established. (Description from Monrovia)
